

The Chaplet Of Divine Mercy

Abbreviated version*

- **1. Make The Sign of the Cross.** Say The Our Father. Say The Hail Mary. Say The Apostles' Creed.
- **2. On the first Rosary Mystery bead say** the following prayer:

Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son, our Lord, Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

- 3. On the Hail Mary beads say the following prayer: For the sake of His sorrowful passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.
- **4. Repeat steps 2 and 3** until you complete the cycle around the Rosary.

Ending prayer, (say three times)

Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

Optional prayer: Eternal God, in whom mercy is endless and the treasury of compassion inexhaustible, look kindly upon us and increase Your mercy in us, that in difficult moments we might not despair nor become despondent but with great confidence submit ourselves to Your Holy Will, which is Love and Mercy itself. Amen.

Divine Mercy has become a leading devotion of the 21st Century. It was to St. Faustina, a humble Polish nun with only three years of formal education, that Jesus revealed His Unfathomable Mercy. He referred to her as His Secretary of Mercy. St. John Paul II canonized her as first saint of the 21st Century. Today Divine Mercy is one of the most popular devotions throughout the world. Divine Mercy Sunday is the first Sunday following Easter.


