Beginning of RFR 40 Years Ago

A Spark Ignites. The story of Radio Family Rosary (RFR) began with a parishioner at St. Francis Xavier Parish, Phoenix, a daily communicant longing to hear the Rosary on the airwaves, just as he had back in Detroit. This simple wish presented a missionary challenge to Dorothy Westfall.

From Inspiration to Action. Seizing the opportunity, friends of Our Lady, with the support of the Knights of Columbus, embarked on the mission of airing locally the Holy Rosary. Through fortuitous encounters, securing funding and technical support of Fr. Roger McAuliffe, SJ, and finally securing radio time, the program was launched. Also, Fred Maholic, who had worked with Fr. Patrick Peyton, CSC, joined the effort. The program began airing on a local Protestant station, 1010 AM, initially once a week and eventually expanding to five days.

A Community of Voices. RFR has been blessed with the participation of internationally and nationally known figures throughout its journey. Cardinals, bishops, prominent priests, as well as local clergy and everyday individuals of faith have lent their voices to the program, offering reflections and prayers that resonate with listeners.

Local parishes, schools, organizations, and Rosary groups record the Rosary for broadcast. RFR continues to invite groups to participate.

RFR promotes and covers many Diocesan events such as AZ Rosary Celebration, Marian Conference, retreats, and other spiritual gatherings.

Indulgences for Holy Souls, November 1-8

The Catholic Church grants an indulgence, applicable only to the Souls in Purgatory, to those who devoutly visit a cemetery and pray, even if only mentally, for the departed. The indulgence is plenary each day from November 1-8. Other days of the year it is only a partial indulgence.

The plenary indulgence is earned under the usual conditions: sacramental confession (within 20 days before or after), one Eucharistic Communion for each visit (20 days before or after), and prayer for the Pope's intentions (usually one Our Father and the Creed or Hail Mary, prayed each visit) while detached from sin.
